Our concerns about how you are looked after, and what is going well

We are concerned that you may not be getting enough to eat at home and are coming to school hungry, which is why you ask other young people at the school for food.

We are concerned that you are attending school in clothes that are grubby and smelly and this has led to some episodes of bullying which you have found very upsetting.

We are concerned about your school attendance and the effect this has on your ability to keep up and make progress.

Your form tutor has said that you are doing well in maths, geography and art. She has said she is confident you could do even better in these and other subjects if your attendance improved.

We have noticed that since your grandmother came to stay you have come in to school every day and your personal presentation has been much better.

What you have told us

You have said that you would like to come to school more often but sometimes you are looking after Jacky. You have also said that when you are at school you worry about how your mum is coping.

You agree that you have been bullied by other children at the school and that they have called you upsetting names. You would like this to stop. You think it might be helpful to speak to a school counsellor about this and any other worries you might have.

What needs to change to make sure you are protected and well looked after

We think that your mum needs to make sure you have breakfast before you leave home or that you attend the school's breakfast club five days a week.

We think that you and your mum need to make sure you have a daily bath or shower. Also, your mum needs to make sure that you have clean clothes for school each day. We think your mum needs to be able to care for Jacky and Rosa without your help so that you can improve your school attendance and keep up with your school work.
