- The purpose of the Leadership Group is to 'drive' the implementation of the LSCB and SAB Business Plan 2016-19
- To be accountable to each respective Board
- To jointly present regular updates to the quarterly main Boards on the progress of the LSCB Business Plan 2016-19 and the SAB Business Plan 2016-19
- To consist of the Chair of the LSCB, Chair of the SAB, the Chairs of the LSCB Subcommittees (Case Review, CPLG, Children & Young People Exploitation Strategic Group, Children & Young People Exploitation Tactical Group, Monitoring & Evaluation, Learning & Development, Participation & Engagement, Early Help), the Chairs of the SAB Subgroups (Safeguarding Adult Review, TBC ASLG, Quality Assurance, Learning & Development), the Heads of Safeguarding, and the Board Manager
- To coordinate and monitor the Business Plan of the LSCB and SAB
- To oversee the work plans of the subcommittees and subgroups to ensure consistency and a joined approach between the groups and the LSCB and SAB
- To develop mechanisms to assure the progress of the subcommittees and subgroups against their work plans
- To ensure the subcommittees and subgroups conduct their business to support the LSCB and SAB Business Plans and collaborate to support each other's work plans where appropriate
- To promote the use of an Outcome Based Accountability approach to monitoring the effectiveness of the LSCB and SAB and their partner agencies to deliver good outcomes for children, families and adults with care and support needs
- To problem solve across more than one subcommittee / subgroup and take action where needed to progress the Business Plans
- To take urgent decisions on behalf of the LSCB and SAB where it is necessary and expedient to do so.
